Comfortability = being in a state of physical or mental comfort; contented and undisturbed



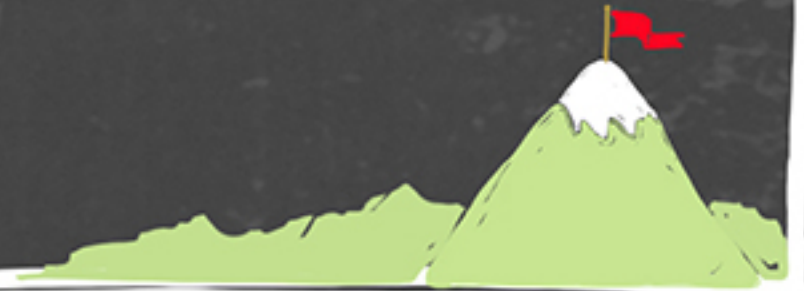

enthusiasm or concern



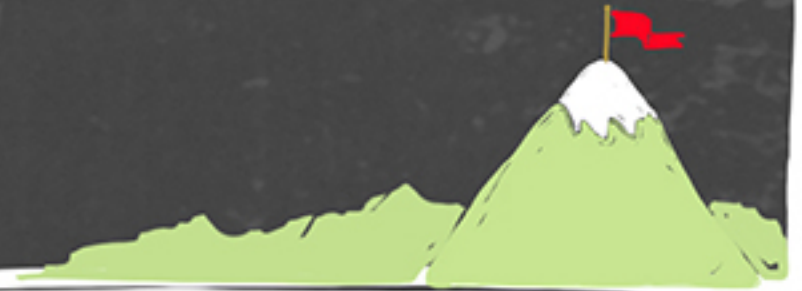

Insecurity = uncertainty or anxiety about oneself; lack of confidence



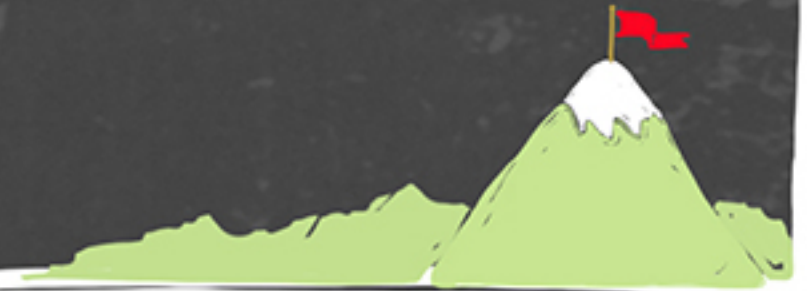

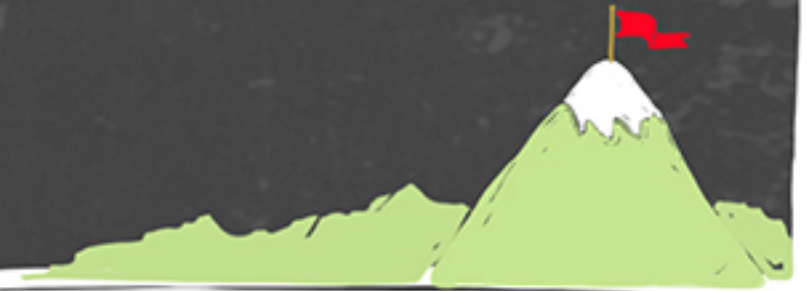

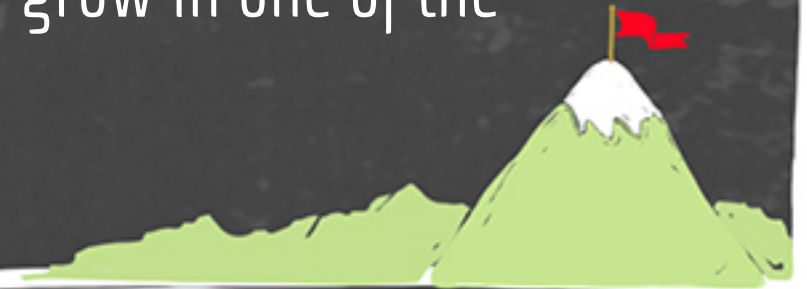

3. What is the next step forward I need to take to grow in one of the character areas identified above?



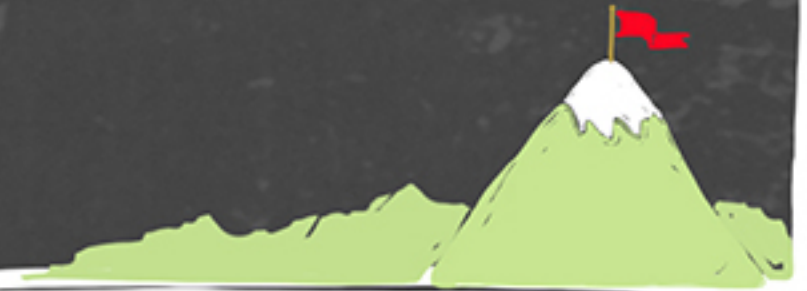
